TAUPO CAR CLUB WINTER CLUBMANS – 21st June 2026 SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS – Part 1 and 2

1. ANNOUNCEMENT & JURISDICTION:

This event is a national Race Meeting, Clubmans Race promoted by the Taupo Car Club (TCC) at Taupo International Motorsport Park.

The Meeting is held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Four, Schedule Z being the Standing Regulations for all Race Meetings and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

3. EVENT DATES: R1-Sunday 21st June 2026 R2- Sunday 26th July 2026 R3- Sunday 23rd August 2026 R4-Sunday 20th September 2026

4. THE VENUE: International Circuit (Circuit 1), Taupo International Motorsport Park, corner of Broadlands Rd & Centennial Dr, Taupo

5. ENTRY CLOSING DATES, ENTRY FEES & ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRY:

5.1 Entry Closing Dates: Will be Saturday the 20th June 7:00pm.

5.2 Entry Fees:

Acceptance of entries will be at the organiser's discretion. Entries must be via Motorsport Online.

The entry fee is **\$190.00** (incl GST & hire transponder if required) per round for all TCC members
The entry fee is **\$220.00**(incl GST & hire transponder if required) per round for all non TCC members.

All entries received after closing date will be accepted at the organizers discretion and the total entry fee will be \$240 including the late fee (Taupo Car Club member or not).

A special price on entries received before the closing date to enter both events - Dual Sprints on Saturday and Clubmans Racing on Sunday will be an entry fee of \$290.00 for TCC members and entry fee of \$350 for non TCC members.

Payment can be made by the following :

- Via the Motorsport Online system.
- Internet banking - Westpac Bank a/c - Taupo Car Club Inc,- 03-0430-0291725-00 (Please use 'C/M' and your initial and surname as the reference)
- Correct amount of Cash only please (no change given).
- EFTPOS will be available on the day for entry fees.

5.3 ENTRY CRITERIA: Acceptance of entries will be at the organiser's discretion. Entries must be via Motorsport Online. Entries will be processed on a first come first entered basis. Dual entries (1 car & 2 drivers) will be accepted at the organiser's discretion.

5.4 Acceptance of Entry: Acceptance of entries will be done via Motorsport Online.

6. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS & UNDERSTANDING:

6.1 Licence Requirements:

The driver must hold as a minimum a C1 Grade Competition Licence.

If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

6.2 Competitors Briefing:

Written drivers briefing will be emailed to all competitors.

Verbal drivers briefing will be held at 08:30am sharp outside the Documentation Office or may be moved to a TIMP Suite. Attendance is compulsory for all competitors.

6.3 New Competitors:

Any competitor(s) who are racing at one of their first three (3) race events or who have not previously competed at the circuit must indicate the fact on the entry form and attend the New Competitors Briefing session. This briefing will take place directly after competitors briefing.

6.4 Competitors understanding:

In signing the entry forms competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular:

- The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitors obligations, and
- Schedule Z Articles detailing Flag signals and Code of Conduct.
- All drivers are to sign in and acknowledge the written drivers briefing has been read.
- All withdrawals throughout the day must be noted on the withdrawal list located in the documentation room.

6.5 Fuel: Competitors are reminded to ensure that they are familiar with and abide by the MotorSport NZ Code of Practice – Fuel Handling. This can be found on the MotorSport NZ website – www.motorsport.org.nz Please notify the documentation volunteers if you are using E85 or any other non-pump fuel. There will be sheet to note your name and vehicle details on.

7. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION:

7.1 Documentation:

Will take place at documentation room from 7:30-8:20am.

7.2 Scrutineering Audit Inspection:

Scrutineering: Will be held at the Scrutineering Shed from 07:30 – 8:20am.

** Please note ** All cars that do not have a logbook will be scrutineered at each event.

8. POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT & ORGANISERS' RIGHTS:

The organisers reserve the right to cancel or abandon the meeting or part thereof should less than the minimum number of entries as prescribed in the regulations/articles not be achieved. In all other instances the minimum number is 10 entries. For reasons of Force Majeure should a meeting or part thereof be cancelled any entry fee refund will be made only at the discretion of the organisers.

9. PROGRAMME OF EVENTS:

Race Formats:

- Qualifying session
- Race 1 (6laps) Standing Start Best lap of Qualifying
- Race 2 (6 laps) Handicap Race Grid Start Best lap of Qualifying and/or Race 1
- Race 3 (6 laps) Handicap Race Grid Start Best lap of Qualifying and/or Race 1 & 2
- Further races may be held if time permitting at the organizer’s discretion – laps and start order to be confirmed on the day

The above is the intended programme of events. In accordance with Appendix Four Schedule Z the organisers reserve the right to amalgamate or delete any event or cancel any race should less than ten entries be received by the closing date.

The eligibility articles mentioned hereunder are subject to the approval of MotorSport New Zealand. In the nature of this club event, groups and start order will be determined by the event organiser and or delegate and is subject to change at any stage throughout the event.

10. SERIES POINTS SYSTEM:

Competitors will be awarded points based on the points table below and from the first THREE races of each group ONLY throughout the individual rounds of the series.

All competitors who complete all four rounds will receive a participation certificate.

11. Transponder Timing:

Timing for the meeting is by the AMB transponder system. If you require the use of a TCC transponder then in signing for the transponder you will be liable for:

- Any loss or damage to the transponder

If you own your own transponder, please ensure the number is recorded on your entry form. No alternative timing method is available. Please ensure your transponder is fitted correctly.

12. Results: These will be available throughout the day posted in the documentation room.

13. Refreshments: Refreshments will be available at the Taupo Car Club Clubrooms at completion of day.

14. GENERAL INFORMATION - FHR REQUIREMENTS PIT LANE & COMPETITION RACE SURFACE

- Frontal Head Restraints (FHR) are mandatory for Clubmans racing for all cars competing with 4 or more strap belts.
- Dogs are NOT allowed within the Taupo International Park grounds
- No spectators under the age of 14 are allowed in the Pit Lane & Dummy Grid areas
- Closed toed shoes MUST be worn in the Pit Lane & Dummy Grid areas.
- The entire area from the ticketing gates to the race circuit is SMOKE & VAPE FREE. Smoking & Vaping is only permitted on the grass area in the pit paddock.
- Use of scooters and skateboards are strictly prohibited on TIMP site.
- Nothing is to be hammered into the Pit Paddock seal. If you are observed doing this you will be asked to remove them & charged with the repair costs.
