

STANDARD SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS PART ONE

MANGATOI ROAD GRAVEL RALLYSPRINT Sunday 19 JULY 2026

1. JURISDICTION

This event is a Clubsport Advanced Event, promoted by Motorsport Bay of Plenty, Tauranga, Bay of Plenty.

The Meeting will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Three, Schedule RS being the Standing Regulations for all Rallysprints and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

3. EVENT DESCRIPTION:

3.1 The event will be a Gravel 8.06km (approx.) Rallysprint.

There will be a Recce and 4 Timed Runs for all competitors. Eliminations will be occurring throughout the day as per the Northern Rallysprint Series Rules. The fastest two cars from each Class will have a 5th run to determine the Class Winner, time permitting. The number of runs may be varied at the organiser's discretion, and the event may be cancelled for reasons of force majeure or safety.

Recce will commence shortly after the completion of the drivers briefing. All competitors must travel the course route in convoy.

It is the driver's responsibility to be lined up in the start queue in their correct running order. Failure to abide may result in you being refused a start in the run. This is to ensure the event can run to time.

Timecards will be issued. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure they are completed and adhered to, to keep the event on time.

There will be a touring section of approximately 3km from the pits to the stage start. Then a touring section of approx. 20.8km to return from the finish to the pits.

Venue

Mangatoai Road, Tauranga, Bay of Plenty.

HQ and Service Park will be at TMMI Hubsite at the TECT Park Whataroa Road

Service Park access is from 7:30am, NO EARLIER. Please arrive from 7:30am.

Toilets are behind the service park.

Food Vendors will be at the Service Area – We have a Coffee Cart , Burgers, Ribs and Beer Battered Fries by The Burger lab – Menu and Pricing Below.

Eftpos will be available but bring cash just in case

More information will be in your acceptance of entry.

3.2 Classes: Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:

- (2) Competitors in the MBOP Club Championship will be awarded points in their usual classes.

3.3 Results

For all NRSS Competitors results will be calculated in accordance with the NRSS Series Articles using BDA Results.

Any car receiving outside assistance to complete a run will be deemed to have not completed the run (i.e., DNF).

Overall event and MBOP Club results will be taken from the fastest run of the day taken from the up to 4 completed runs. (i.e., not including the Top 2 Run Off).

4. ENTRIES:

4.1 Entries **must** be made through the MotorSport Online system.

Any entry will not be deemed valid until payment is received.

Acceptance will be at the Organiser's discretion. Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

4.2 Opening and Closing Dates:

Entries open with the publication of these regulations and will be accepted up until midnight Tuesday 14 July 2026. Entries after the normal closing date but received prior to Midnight, Thursday, 16 July 2026 will be subject to a late entry fee. Entries close Midnight, Thursday 16 July 2026. No entries will be accepted on the day.

Due to the touring distance in this event dual drivers cannot be accommodated, and vehicles MUST be registered and warranted.

4.3 Entry Fees:

The Entry fee for MBOP Members for this event is \$300.00, including GST per competitor.

The Entry fee for Non-MBOP Members for this event is \$320.00, including GST per competitor.

The late entry fee for this event is an additional \$50.00, including GST per competitor.

Any competitor withdrawing from the event up to the close of entry date must notify any one of the above officials asap to qualify for a refund.

4.4 Number of Starters: The organisers reserve the right to abandon the event if less than 20 competitors are received at normal closing date.

5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS and UNDERSTANDING:

5.1 Licence Requirements:

All drivers must hold as a minimum an M Grade Competition Licence and current membership with a member club. All drivers shall hold a valid civil driver's licence.

If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

5.2 Competitor Understanding:

In submitting the entry competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular:

- The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitor's obligations, and Appendix Three, Schedule RS.
- All competitors shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A.
- All Drivers must sign the CSport002a-ClubSport-Driver-Passenger-Ride-Declaration
- All Passengers must sign the CSport002b-ClubSport-Passenger-Declaration Form prior to their participation; it is the driver's responsibility to ensure this is done.
- Drivers must brief all passengers on basic event safety procedures, how to wear and subsequently uncouple the safety harness.
- The start line will check that the passenger has signed the indemnity & declaration form before allowing the vehicle to start, if the passenger is found to not have signed said indemnity & declaration form then the vehicle will be removed from the Start Line and this may cause the driver to forfeit their run.
- The minimum age of any passenger is 12 years. Passengers under the age of 16 must have a completed "ClubSport Event Underage Indemnity and Consent Form" (MSNZ form CSport002) or a MSNZ Competition Licence stamped "Authorised Minor". Form CSport002 can be downloaded from the MSNZ Website or will be available at the event. This is to be signed by a parent or legal guardian (not just the person taking care of them on the day).
- Any competitor who causes damage to Public Property, MBOP's, or their Sponsor's Property will be billed for the damage up to the excess of the Public Liability Insurance Policy in the name of Motorsport New Zealand Inc. (Note: current policy excess of \$3500.00)

6. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

6.1 Compliance: All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Three Schedule RS and Appendix Two Schedule A of the current MotorSport Manual unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations.

6.2 All vehicles must have a WOF and Registration.

6.3 Electric vehicles cannot be accommodated at this event.

7. TIMETABLE

7.1 Documentation:

Saturday 18th July 16.00 – 17.00 documentation for MBOP competitors or other competitors available at the time. The venue will be PF Automotive 95 Birch Avenue Tauranga.

Sunday 19th July 07.30 -08.30 documentation at the service park at the event trailer for out-of-town competitors only.

REMINDER: Paper Logbooks are required to be presented at Documentation and to be filled out by your remote scrutineer.

7.2 Scrutineering Audit Inspection:

ALL COMPETITORS must Remote Scrutineer. Please contact your local Scrutineer to arrange a pre-event audit.

Event audit information will be available from 6th July – all scrutineers will be able to access this.

REMINDER: Paper Logbooks are required to be presented at Documentation and to be filled out by your remote scrutineer.

Remote Scrutineering for all competitors is required for this event:

*******There will be no Scrutineering on the day*******

7.3 Accident Damage: Competitors are reminded that, in accordance with Schedule A Part 1, Article 3.4 (8), if there is significant damage sustained, it is the Competitor's responsibility to present the vehicle and Logbook to the Event Chief Scrutineer for inspection and notation of any applicable information.

7.4 Drivers' Briefing: 08:45. This will be held at the venue by the Event Trailer. Attendance by all drivers is compulsory – a roll call will be taken and failure to attend will result in a penalty.

7.5 Recce and Subsequent Timed Runs: 09:30 or earlier at CotC discretion.

8. POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT & ORGANISERS' RIGHTS:

8.1 Pursuant to national Sporting Code Article 13, the organisers advise that if less than 20 entries are received by the entry closing date the meeting may be postponed or cancelled.

9. OFFICIAL BULLETINS

9.1 Official Bulletins may be issued in accordance with the provisions of the National Sporting Code.

10. GENERAL INFORMATION

- 10.1 Passengers:** May only be carried in accordance with Appendix Five, Schedule C Article 6.2.
- 10.2** **There is NO Spectator access to the Stage. This includes walking in from both the start and the finish.**
- 10.3** Alcohol is not permitted to be consumed by any competitor or their crew at the event before or during the day's competition.
- 10.4** Marshals will be needed to help. Please contact Kirsty on 022 174 3681 if you have someone that wants to help out.
