

## TWILIGHT AUTOCROSS - SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. The event will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the HBCC Autocross Rules (2025), the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Five, Schedule C being the Standing Regulations for all ClubSport Events and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

**ENTRY FEE:**  
Entry Fee including GST (for HBCC Members) \$ 45.00  
Entry Fee including GST (for non-club members) \$ 55.00  
**\$5.00 from every entry will be donated to the Hawkes Bay Rescue Helicopter Trust**
3. This is a **ClubSport Basic** level, MSNZ Permitted event. Membership of a MSNZ affiliated Club is required if you have already competed in two (2) previous events.
4. All entries must be on an official HBCC entry form. Entries will be accepted on the day at the venue **from 3.00pm to 3.45pm, online entries via the MSNZ online system are the preferred method of entry. Competitors paying online must bring proof of transaction if payment is made after the preceding Thursday.** Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.
5. You must report to Documentation to enter first. You will be told whether or not you will need to be scrutineered. **Scrutineering is from 3.00pm to 4.00pm at the venue.**
6. **Drivers' Briefing:** This will be held at **4.15pm**. Attendance by all drivers is compulsory – a roll call will be taken and failure to attend will result in a penalty.
7. Alcohol is not permitted to be consumed by any competitor or their crew at the event before or during the competition. This will result in Immediate expulsion from the event.
8. Competition numbers supplied by HBCC must be returned in the condition they were given out in at the conclusion of the event or there will be a charge of \$10.00
9. All competitors must start the practice or recce run to be eligible to take part in the official runs. There will be one practice or recce run which will take place at the beginning of the event. All competitors shall have the same number of runs. There will be three (3) official runs on the course
10. **AUTOCROSS TYRES:** Tyres shall be as per the HBCC 2025 Autocross Rules. Normal road or racing tyres are permitted. No rally-type pattern, studs or chains are permitted. The Clerk of the Course will be Jidge of Fact.
11. Prizegiving will be held in the HBCC Clubrooms after the event. Cash Bar and Food will be available. There is NO EFTPOS facility.

**Passengers** may only be carried at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course provided that Appendix Five, Schedule C Article 6.2. All vehicles carrying passengers shall be fitted with the following equipment, which must comply with Appendix 2, Schedule A – Roll cage, both front seats, four, five or six point safety harnesses for both occupants. Passengers shall wear safety apparel as specified in the safety schedule contained in Appendix 2, Schedule A. All passengers shall be briefed on basic event safety procedures, how to correctly wear and subsequently uncouple the safety harness and shall sign the passenger indemnity and declaration form prior to their participation. It is the responsibility of the driver to provide this briefing, as well as also signing the passenger ride form. Passengers under the age of 16 are not permitted unless they hold a Motorsport NZ authorised minors licence, and between 12 and 16 years of age must present a valid Junior Competition Licence or an underage indemnity form signed by a parent or guardian. Passengers may change between runs.
